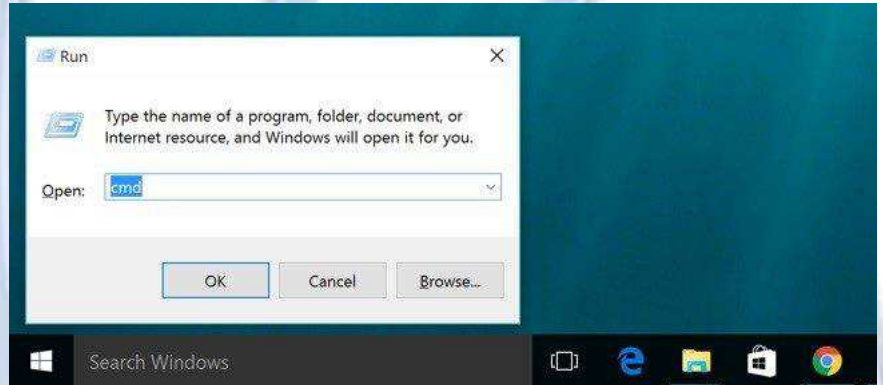


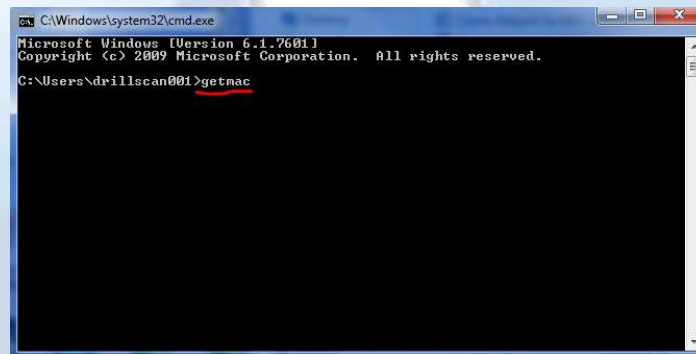
How To Get Your MAC Address

Open Command Prompt for Windows 10

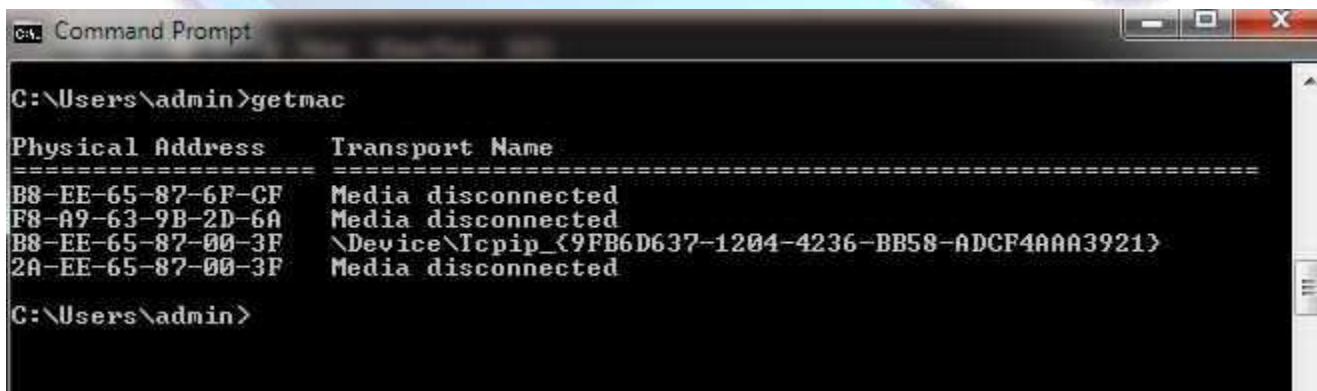
- Press the “Win +R” keys to open the RUN dialog box. Type cmd, and click/tap OK.



- In this command window, type “getmac”. Details are going to be shown for the computer's network adapters.



- The 'Physical Address' field states the MAC address for that adapter (Wireless or Ethernet). Please send us the screen shot of your information as per the example below.

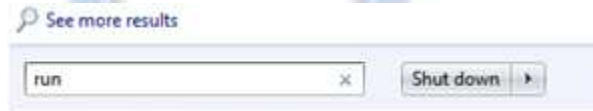


Open Command Prompt for Windows 7, Vista or XP

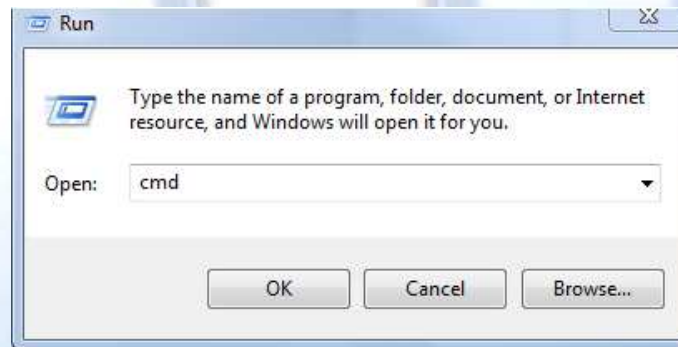
- Click the Start menu button on the Windows taskbar.



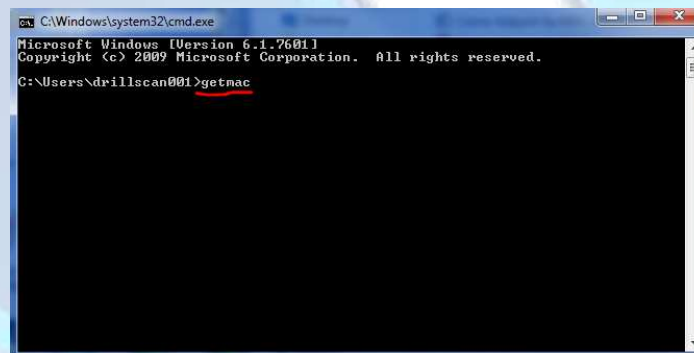
- Type 'Run' on the search field
